Session One

"How a Safe Schools' community responded to a cluster of student deaths"

Facilitated panel discussions of the challenges faced and the successful interventions by the Interboro School District as they worked to protect at risks students, combat rumors and stabilize their Community following several events earlier this year.

Session Two

"The legal challenges faced by Educators when using Social Media to protect students from bullying, when Educators communicate on-line with students as "friends," and recognizing "Social Media" warning signs of students at risk for suicide"

The District Attorney's Office will present on three Social Media topics. The first topic will be a presentation on what constitutes "Online Bullying & Harassment by students". The second will focus on "Legal & Ethical Considerations" Schools should be aware of when their faculty and students communicate "socially" online. Also, an expert who works with at risk students will discuss ways to interrupt the path to suicide.

Dr. Nancy Hacker, Superintendent of the Interboro School District, will share her recent experience managing the safety or her students and faculty in the weeks and months following multiple traumatic events in her community.
